Call for proposals Special Research Grant for Advisors of New Students

The Grand Technion Energy Program (GTEP) offers a **special research grant** for faculty members who recruit students to their research groups through the Interdisciplinary Energy Graduate Studies Program.

The Grand Technion Energy Program (GTEP) assigns the highest importance to training the next generation of energy researchers and engineers. These graduates will integrate into industry, academia, and the energy sector, becoming future leaders in addressing national and global challenges in the field of energy. **The GTEP Interdisciplinary Energy Graduate Studies Program** features a revolutionary curriculum, bringing together engineers and scientists across disciplines. This challenging, highly interdisciplinary program is designed to educate future energy leaders in all types of renewable and classic energy sources.

The program integrates dedicated "soft skill" courses, such as Entrepreneurship in Energy, Systems Engineering in Energy, and AI in Energy, equipping graduates to lead in the national and global thriving energy ecosystem. Through a systems-oriented approach, it prepares graduates to tackle both national and global energy challenges with innovative solutions.

Starting from the Spring Semester of 2025, in conjunction with the launch of the new curriculum, GTEP offers a **special research grant** for faculty members who recruit students to their research groups through the Interdisciplinary Energy Graduate Studies Program.

The funding allocation for the first and second new GTEP students (Spring Semester 2025) will be as follows:

Eligibility

- Open to faculty members who accept new graduate students (MSc or PhD) into their research groups through the GTEP Interdisciplinary Energy Graduate Studies Program for the Spring Semester of 2025 only.
- Each faculty member may receive support for up to two new students (MSc and PhD combined).
- To be eligible, the PI's student must first be accepted into the Energy Interdisciplinary Graduate Studies Program, complete registration for the Energy Graduate Studies Program, and receive approval from the GTEP Interdisciplinary Graduate Studies Committee.

Clarifications and Conditions:

- A faculty member may apply for only one grant per student up to two students maximum.
- Granted funds will be processed through the MANLAM office following MANLAM Grants regulations. Expenditures will be permitted only within the research grants regulations of the Technion.
- The total budget is limited. Funding will be allocated in the order applications are received until the budget is fully utilized. Applications submitted after the budget is exhausted will not be funded. The continuation of this call for the next academic years is **subject to GTEP's future resources**.
