



Winter semester 2025-2026/ תשפ"ו Call for Proposals Special Research Grant for Advisors of New Students

The Grand Technion Energy Program (GTEP) offers a special research grant for faculty members who recruit students to their research groups through the Interdisciplinary Energy Graduate Studies Program. Following the success of the previous round, this initiative will continue for the Winter Semester of 2025-2026 academic year.

The GTEP Interdisciplinary Energy Graduate Studies Program offers a groundbreaking curriculum led by world-renowned experts from academia and industry. Designed to train Israel's next energy experts, the program promotes innovation across diverse energy fields through a broad, cross-disciplinary approach.

GTEP offers a **special research grant for faculty members** who recruit students to their research groups through the Interdisciplinary Energy Graduate Studies Program.

Funding

The funding allocation for the first and second new GTEP students (beginning their studies in Winter Semester 2025-2026) will be as follows:

Advisor's Number of New GTEP Students	MSc	PhD
1 st and 2 nd students (incl. VAT)	\$10,000	\$11,000

Eligibility

- Open to Technion faculty members who accept new graduate students (MSc or PhD) into their research groups through the GTEP Interdisciplinary Energy Graduate Studies Program, starting in Winter Semester 2025-2026.
- Each faculty member may receive support for up to two new students (combined MSc and PhD).
- Funding will be provided only after the students have started their studies.





Submission

To apply, please submit the following documents:

- A short cover letter listing the names of your GTEP student(s) and the titles of their research projects.
- A brief research proposal for each project, including: Pl's name, research title, research description, and planned budget.
- Note: The research grant is awarded to the PI, and the submission must be made by the PI.

Clarifications and Conditions:

- A faculty member may apply for one grant per student, up to a maximum of two students.
- Granted funds will be processed through the MANLAM office following MANLAM Grants regulations. Expenditures will be permitted only within the research grants regulations of the Technion.
- Grantees are required to submit scientific summary reports at the end of the first and second years.
- All reports, publications, and presentations must include the following: Acknowledgment: "The Nancy and Stephen Grand Technion Energy Program".
 Affilation: the researcher's affiliation in papers should (also) list the Grand Technion Energy Program.
- The total budget is limited. Funding will be allocated in the order applications are received until the budget is fully utilized. Applications submitted after the budget is exhausted will not be funded.
- The continuation of this call in future semesters or academic years is subject to GTEP's available resources.
